#### **USE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION**

The personal data of a Student and/or Parent submitted when starting classes at Grayes will be processed and used solely by Grayes Theatre Arts for the purposes of administration and the operation of Grayes in its training in Dance and the Performing Arts.

No disclosure of personal data will be given to third parties for marketing purposes. Grayes Theatre Arts may use personal data for our own marketing purposes, including for the purposes of advertising and promoting new products and/or services.

# **PHOTOGRAPHS**

Grayes Theatre Arts may take photographs and film footage of students during classes, holiday courses, workshops and performances. This footage may be used for marketing and publicity material to advertise Grayes. If anyone is not happy with their child being involved, please let me know or I will assume that they can be photographed and their picture used.

## **HEALTH AND INJURIES**

Students participate at their own risk and are obliged to inform teachers of any existing injuries or medical condition. All known medical conditions must be announced when signing up to classes. Any changes to such information must be notified to L-A immediately in writing.

Any medication needed while in our care should be clearly labelled and the student should, unless agreed in writing otherwise, be able to administer it themselves.
